In the Name of God Amen.  
I Edward Goodale Merchant of the City of London being of sound mind and healthy body provided before for the same and considering the uncertainty of life do make this my last Will and Testament in manner following First my Will and desire is that all my just debts and funeral charges be paid within one year after my decease by my Executors hereafter named. I then to say I give unto and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Goodale all and singular all my personal property of all my Goods and Chattels whatsoever and wheresoever that I shall die possessor of my just debts and funeral charges being first paid as above And I do hereby appoint my said lawful wife Elizabeth Goodale to be my Executor to this my last Will and Testament without any interruption lawfully to enjoy the remainder of my said property and dispose of the same at her own discretion Given under my hand and seal this 24th day of Nov. 1788 Edward Goodall his X mark Signed Sealed and Delivered being first published in the presence of the Testator and in the presence of each other Witnesses I Barnes the mark X of J. M. Threll Witnesses J. Barnes

This Will was proved at London the first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty one before the Worshipful George Davis Doctor of Laws and Surrogate of the Right Honourable Sir William Arden Knight Doctor of Laws Master Keeper or Commissary of the Prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by the Oath of Elizabeth Goodale otherwise Goodall Widow the eldest of the deceased and sole Executrix named in the said Will to whom Administration was granted of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased leaving both first sworn duly to administer

William In the Name of God Amen  
Greenly I William Greenly of the City of London Merchant do make this my last Will and Testament in manner following that is to say First I recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God my Creator humbly desiring to obtain forgiveness of my sins through the merits of our Redeemer Jesus Christ and I commit my body to the Earth to be decently interred at the discretion of my dear Wife Ann Greenly and also my Executors hereafter named And as to such worldly Estate whatsoever it shall please God to bless me I dispose thereof as follows that is to say First my Will is that all my just



costs and funeral Expenses shall be paid and satisfied as soon as conveniently may be after my decease I give to my said Wife the Sum of thirty pounds of lawful Money of Great Britain to be paid her within one Calendar Month next after my decease for her own use and benefit And I give and bequeath all the rest and residue of my personal Estate whatsoever and wheresoever unto my worthy friend Gabriel Aley of Albemarle Street in the parish of Saint John Clerkenwell in the County of Middlesex Solicitor and Executors and Administrators upon the trust following that is to say upon trust that he do and shall raise or procure an Inventory Valuation and Appraisement to be made thereof as soon as conveniently may be after my decease and my Will and intended And I do hereby direct that my said Wife shall sign the said Inventory and that my said Trustee shall keep the same and that he shall sign a Copy thereof and deliver it to my said Wife And my further Will is that my said Trustee Executors and Administrators do and shall permit and suffer my said Wife to leave the possession and use of the said Trust Estate to carry on the said Business of a Victualler until she shall marry or die where she shall first happen to the Intent and purpose that she my said Wife may be thereby better enabled to maintain and support herself and any said Children And in case my said Wife shall marry again after my decease then my Will is that my Trustee for the time being do and shall at his own discretion either permit or suffer my said Wife to continue in the possession and use of the said Trust Estate for carrying on the said Business of a Victualler for the purpose aforesaid so long as my said Trustee shall think fit or at any time after my Marriage to sell and dispose of the said Trust Estate and lay out and divert the Money arising by such sale and disposition in fees or other non Manors or Mannors or upon some Publick fund or Government Security and stand and be possessed and interested in such fund or security upon trust to pay the said Dividends and yearly proceeds thereof during the natural life of my said Wife unto her proper heirs of my said Wife or to such person or persons as she shall from time to time by writing under her hand and direct appoint such Dividends and yearly proceeds to be for the separate use and benefit of my said Wife apart from her then present or any future husband and whosoever or they shall no ways intermeddle nor shall the same be subject to his or their Debts engagements power or authority and the receipt and receipts of my said Wife or of the persons or persons to whom she shall direct the same to be paid as aforesaid shall from time to time notwithstanding be a good and sufficient discharge and effectual charges to my said Trustee for the time being for so



money as shall be hereon <sup>expressly</sup> mentioned  
and from and after the decease of my said wife my Will is  
that the Trustee for the time being of the Trust Estate herein  
given and bequeathed do and shall stand and be possessed  
thereof and interested therein or of and in such part thereof  
as shall here remain either in Trade or in or upon any  
publick Fund or Government Security in Trust for my only  
Child if but one or of all my Children if more than one  
whom shall be living at the time of my decease equally to  
be divided between or amongst them of more than one  
share and share alike provided always that it shall and  
may be lawful to and for my said Trustee for the time being  
of my said Trust Estate to permit and suffer my son  
William Greenly within three Calendar Months next after  
my decease to have and enjoy the possession and use  
of my said Trust Estate jointly with my said wife  
for carrying on the said Business of a Banker for his  
purpose aforesaid if my said Trustee shall think him  
a fit and proper person to be admitted therewith and my  
said wife shall thereupon on the said Business any  
thing herein contained to the contrary thereof notwithstanding  
provided further that the said Gabriel Albert his Executors  
and Administrators shall not nor shall he or they be  
answerable or accountable for any Trust Money otherwise  
than for what he or they shall actually receive and  
not for any loss that may happen to my said Trust  
Estate or any part thereof by any ways or means whatsoever  
so as such loss do not happen by or through his or their  
wilful Neglect or default and that it shall and may be  
lawful for my said Trustee his Executors and Administrators  
to deduct and retain to himself and himself or out of such  
Trust Money as shall come to him or their hands all  
Costs charges Damages and Expenses whatsoever which  
he or they shall or may sustain or be put unto in the  
execution of the Trust herein created or any of them  
or any ways relating thereto also to my said Gabriel  
alive the sum of Ten Guineas for a Ring or mourning  
in remembrance of me I nominate and appoint my said  
wife Ann Greenly and the said Gabriel Albert joint Executors  
and Executor of this my Will and I do hereby revoke all  
former Wills by me made and declare this only to be my  
last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand to this last sheet of and my  
hand and seal to this last sheet this fifteenth day  
of February in the year of our Lord One thousand seven  
hundred and Eighty three William Greenly Ad Signific
